Swire Launches New Scholarship Scheme

The scholarships will provide an eye-opening opportunity for Hong Kong students to study in Mainland China

Swire announced today the launch of a new scholarship scheme, the Swire China Scholarships, which will provide funding to Hong Kong students pursuing tertiary education at nine renowned universities in Mainland China. The scholarships will cover tuition fees and living expenses for the full period of study.

The scholarships will be open to students who are permanent residents of Hong Kong and have received an offer for an undergraduate programme at any of the following nine universities: Renmin University of China, Beijing Normal University, Shanghai Jiao Tong University, Zhejiang University, Nanjing University, Xiamen University, Sun Yat-sen University, Sichuan University and Chongqing University.

Mr Ivan Chu, Chairman of John Swire & Sons (China) Limited, said, "Swire has a long history of educational sponsorship in Hong Kong and further afield. The Swire China Scholarships is the first scheme specifically catering to Hong Kong students who wish to further their studies on the mainland. For these young people, living and studying in Mainland China will be a defining moment on their career journeys. They will gain first-hand knowledge about the fast-growing social and economic developments, which will broaden their horizons and enhance their future prospects."

Swire has been established in China for over 150 years. Today, it has diversified business interests that include property investment and management, aviation services, beverage production and distribution, cold storage and logistics, food production and distribution, multipurpose liner shipping services, the distribution and retail of sports and lifestyle branded goods, and the manufacturing and distribution of decorative paints. The Group's total capital employed on the mainland exceeds RMB80 billion.

Mr Chu added, "We believe the central government's strategy for economic development, with its increasing emphasis on innovation and urban expansion, will create new opportunities for Swire and for Hong Kong. We hope that students in Hong Kong can witness the fascinating story of China's growth for themselves, and benefit from it."

The Swire China Scholarships will be awarded to students who attain outstanding results in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination. They should also demonstrate strong communication and leadership skills, a commitment to Hong Kong's communities and have an interest in Chinese culture. The scholarships will be awarded to successful applicants annually for the full duration of their degree courses.

The scholarships will be awarded to the first batch of 15 students in the academic year 2018/19.
