



## SWIRE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP Tenable at Any Hong Kong Higher Education Institutions 2026/27

Swire is offering scholarships for Hong Kong students tenable at any of the higher education institution in Hong Kong to pursue their passion and serve the community.

This Scholarship is known as Swire Youth Scholarship and will be awarded annually to ten students on a competitive basis under the following conditions:

### Tenure

This Scholarship will be tenable for the full duration of the successful applicant's chosen course, up to four years, subject to satisfactory annual progress.

### Eligibility

This Scholarship is restricted to permanent residents of Hong Kong. Applicants must be first-time candidates for their university-entrance public examinations in the same academic year as their application.

Applicants can be applying for a full-time Bachelor's, Higher Diploma, or Associate degree (except for Medicine degrees), offered by any higher education institutions recognised by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong. ### Selection Criteria

The applicants will be evaluated based on the information provided on their application. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by a Scholarship Selection Committee, composed of members from Swire and external experts.

The selection of candidates for the Swire Youth Scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

- Track record of pursuing their passion, may it be in academic or vocational field;
- Demonstration of genuine leadership and resilience;
- Commitment to serve the community;
- Financial situation of the applicant;
- Length of applicant's primary and secondary education in Hong Kong may be considered.

### Value

This Scholarship provides an HK\$80,000 per annum grant designed to cover a UGC-funded degree's tuition fees, complemented by a dedicated stipend for living expenses.

It should be noted that should a scholar chooses to pursue a degree outside of the UGC coverage, the scholarship amount may not fully offset the total tuition costs.

Beyond financial support, recipients are welcomed into the Swire Scholar Community. This vibrant network offers exclusive access to our alumni as well as the Swire Trust Mentorship programme, providing a unique platform to engage with and receive career guidance from established professionals across the Swire Group's diverse reach.

### Other Terms

The successful candidate for the 2026/27 Scholarship, if awarded, will start his or her studies in September 2026.

An award recipient cannot hold concurrently a Swire Scholarship with any other non-government scholarship.

## Important Dates

Application is open until **22 May 2026 at 6pm Hong Kong Time**.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited for interview in late July to August 2026.

Results will be announced by late August 2026.

Please note that incomplete or incorrect information may lead to the disqualification of your application, or the withdrawal of any scholarship awarded.

Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interview.

### Mandatory Application Documents:

- Academic transcript of the past one year,
- Most relevant diplomas or degree certificates,
- Two signed reference letters with letterhead of the school or institution they represent along with their contact information. The referees must include at least one principal or teacher of the school you are attending currently,
- A clear copy of your Identity Card (both sides) or Passport bio-data page.

### Optional Supplementary Documents:

- School/university offer (Conditional or unconditional),
- Proof of financial aid or need if applicable, such as an award letter from financial aid office, or Parents' or guardians' pay slip, tax return, or bank statement.

You may be required to present true copies of all the documents or letters upon request.
