



SWIRE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

Tenable at University College, the University of Oxford 2027/28

Swire is offering a scholarship for Hong Kong undergraduate students tenable at University College, Oxford, to pursue their academic aspirations and broaden their international connectedness. This Scholarship is known as the Swire Youth Scholarship and will be awarded annually to one student on a competitive basis under the following conditions:

Tenure

This Scholarship will be tenable for a period of up to four years, subject to the nature of the course and continued satisfactory academic progress.

Quota

One Scholarship will be awarded each year.

Eligibility

Eligibility for the Scholarship is restricted to permanent residents of HK who have completed the majority of their formal education in HK. Applicants must have the intention of returning to HK after their studies to pursue a career in business, government or in a recognised profession. The successful candidate for the 2027 Scholarship must be in receipt of a conditional or unconditional offer of a place at University College, Oxford, for three-year or four-year undergraduate study commencing in October 2027. Subsequent application for migration from any other College to University College will not be accepted.

Please check information on course pre-requisites at Oxford's website www.ox.ac.uk/study. Details of the application procedure for undergraduate admissions and relevant diary dates are available on the same website and must be strictly adhered to.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be considered based on the information provided in their application. The selection criteria include:

- Strong academic achievement;
- Track record in pursuing their academic aspirations;
- Commitment to contribute towards the community;
- Financial situation of the applicant.

Value

This Scholarship is designed to cover the tuition fees, together with a living allowance of GBP16,000 per year and a one-off travel stipend to cover travel to the UK.

Beyond financial support, recipients are welcomed into the Swire Scholar Community. This network offers access to our alumni as well as Mentorship Programme, providing a platform to engage with and receive career guidance from established professionals across the Swire Group's diverse reach.

Other Terms

The successful candidate for the 2027/28 Scholarship, if awarded, will start their studies in the 2027/28 academic year.

An award recipient cannot hold concurrently a Swire Scholarship with any other non-government scholarship.

Scholars are required to inform Swire of any non-UK fieldwork lasting more than one month.

Important Dates

Application is open until **30 November 2026 at 6pm Hong Kong Time**.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited for interview in Q1 2027.

Applicants are reminded to submit their course application to University College, Oxford via UCAS by the UCAS deadline.

Please note that incomplete or incorrect information may lead to the disqualification of your application, or the withdrawal of any scholarship awarded.

- Most relevant diplomas or degree certificates,
- Two signed reference letters on school letterhead, including contact details of the referees. The referees must be the principal and one teacher from your school.
- A clear copy of your Identity Card (both sides) or Passport bio-data page.

Optional Supplementary Documents:

- University offer (Conditional or unconditional),
- Proof of financial aid or need if applicable, such as an award letter from financial aid office, or Parents' or guardians' pay slip, or tax return.

You may be required to present true copies of all the documents or letters upon request.
